How do I Change an Operator's Password?

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- 1. You can use the **Search Field** Operator or **Filter** to find the operator of interest
- 2. Select the operator and then either double click on the row or click the **edit icon**
- 3. Click the **unlock button** inext to the password field
- 4. Enter a new "Password," then confirm the password by entering it a second time in the "Confirm Password" field
- 5. Click **Save** and the password will be Updated for the selected Operator

Multiple operator passwords can be updated within a data table at one time

- To select continuous rows, on your computer keyboard, click one row, then hold the Shift key and click the last row. To select non-continuous rows, click one row, then hold the Ctrl key, and select multiple rows
- 2. Then **right click on your mouse** on the rows and select **"Edit General"** from the pop-up menu
- 3. Check the box next to Password and enter a new password, then Confirm Password
- 4. Click **OVERWRITE** in the lower right corner and the selected operators will have their passwords Updated
