## How do I Create a Linearity Task for Manual Execution of Charts?

## To create a Linearity Task:

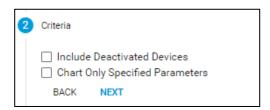
1. From the **Tasks Page**, (located in the black Navigation Panel), click • Add, in the top, right corner of the screen.



- 2. Fill in the General Card.
  - Enter the **Name** for the Linearity Task (*For multi-institution servers, it is a good idea to include hospital mnemonic in the name of the Task*).
  - Task Type: Linearity
  - Device Type: Choose Device TypeInstitution: Choose Institution
  - Click Next.



3. Fill in the Criteria Card, if desired, and click NEXT.

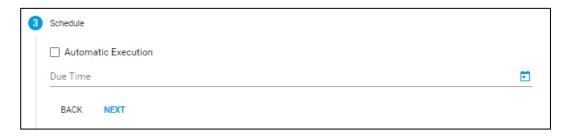






## How do I Create a Linearity Task for Manual Execution of Charts?

4. Fill in the **Schedule** card, if needed, and click **NEXT**.



5. Enter Notes, if desired, and click SAVE.



**To Manually Execute a Linearity Task:** For multi-institution servers, it is recommended to filter for only the desired institution and **Save** the view.

1. From the **Tasks** Page, highlight the desired **Linearity Task** and click **Execute**, in the top, right corner.



2. Ensure the date of testing is included in the date range for task execution and click **EXECUTE**.
