


UNSOLICITED INTERFACE



- 1. Patient test is required
- 2. No order with an order number in the HIS/EMR and the device operator is directed to perform the test based on hospital protocols
- 3. The test is performed and the Patient ID is entered into the point-of-care device
- 4. The POC device downloads the test result to RALS (flowing through evaluation checks)
- 5. RALS sends the test result to the Hospital Unsolicited LIS Interface for processing
 - RALS Outbound Interface uses ADT (must be received from HIS) to validate based on the meter's time stamp:
 - Patient ID is present in ADT
 - Patient currently admitted
 - If in-unit ADT active, patient is in the correct location
 - RALS Outbound Interface builds and sends an unsolicited HL7 message containing:
 - Patient information: Who is the test run on
 - Order information: What test is being ordered
 - Result information: What is the test result(s)
- 6. The patient test result is posted to the patient record under the Order Number / Accession Number
